# Switch Progression

- Step One Single Switch Cause and Effect (Cognitive)  
Exploration and Making Something Happen
- Step Two Single Switch Multiple Location/Multiple Function (Motor)
- Step Three Two Switches 2 Functions (Cognitive)

**DECISION**  
Move to Two Switch Scanning or Single Switch Automatic Scanning

**Two Switch Step-Scanning**  
Student has more control of moving from one item to another, less concentration/focus needed, two switch sites needed. Do not need accurate timing of switch hit

Step Four – Learning Scanning (Cognitive)  
Move, Move, get – Learning that one switch moves something along a path and the second switch selects or “gets it”  
If understands concept, move to step 5 practice

Step Five – Failure Free with Feedback (Motor)  
Continued practice with automaticity – choice with feedback

Step Six Two Switch Step Scanning to a Target (Motor)  
One switch moves over an array of null, blank, or non-selectable items. Other switch selects the one active target

Step 7 Practice for Increasing Accuracy

**One Switch Automatic Scanning**  
May require less motor effort for some students, but is often more fatiguing due to high demands on concentration, holding attention to task, timing of motor movements – Child needs to quickly activate switch upon intent

Step Four A Part 1 Learning Time  
Activating switch when item appears.

Step Four A Part 2 Learning Scanning (Cognitive)  
Scan automatically moves through choices

Step Five A Failure Free Learning with Feedback (Motor)  
Selection of choice with appropriate feedback. Every choice provides feedback. Linear scan

Step Six A Automatic scanning to a Target  
Automatically moves over an array of null, blank items. One item is selectable.

Step 7A Practice for Increasing Accuracy

Step 8 Switch Automaticity – Reducing time for Success and Demonstrating Knowledge  
Increase efficiency - grouping

## Setting Accessibility Shortcut

1<sup>st</sup> thing to do is set Accessibility Shortcut, so you can easily move in and out of switch activation

Settings > General > Accessibility > Accessibility shortcut (scroll down to the bottom)

Can easily turn on and off guided access, switch control, voiceover, etc. using a triple click of home button.

For today check switch control.

## Setting up Switch Assignments

Make sure your switch interface is connected.

Make assignments to your switches.

On the iPad – teach switches what they will do

Start with Settings > General > Accessibility > Switch Control > Choose Switches > Add a new switch > External

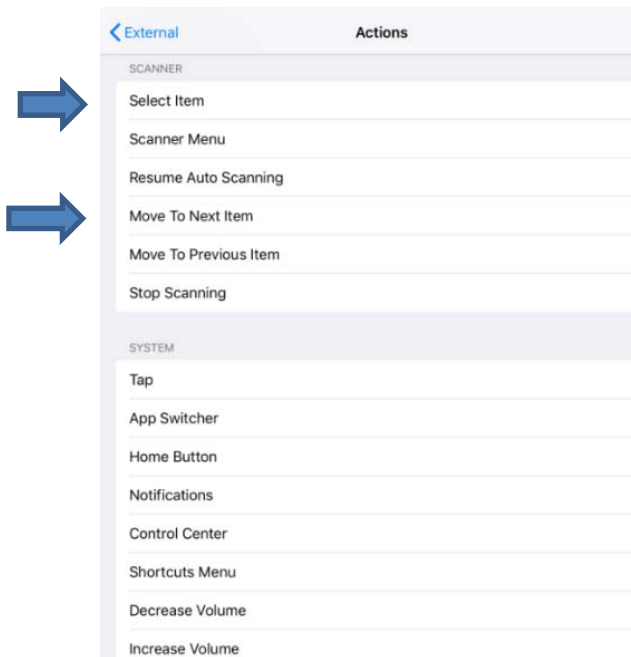


### Activate your external switch

External switches can be Bluetooth, MIDI, or Made for iPhone Assistive Switch Control devices.



Choose your default action. For example, if you want to use switches for two switch scanning – may want one to be to move to the next item and second to be the choosing switch (select item).



## Creating a Recipe

Decide for your program, what actions will be needed. In the Hill Climber app you will need an activation for gas and one for brake

Other combinations might be tap the screen in the middle to read it, swipe from right to left to turn page ahead

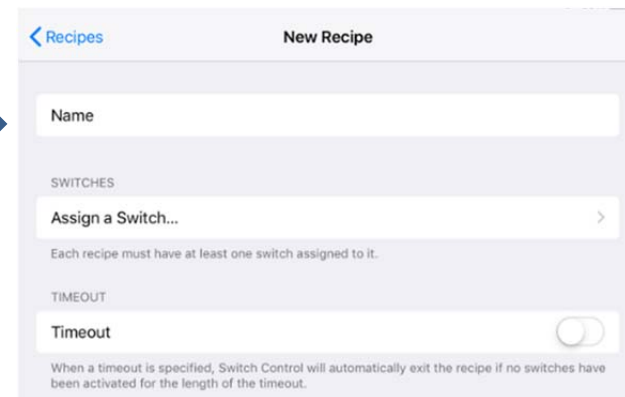
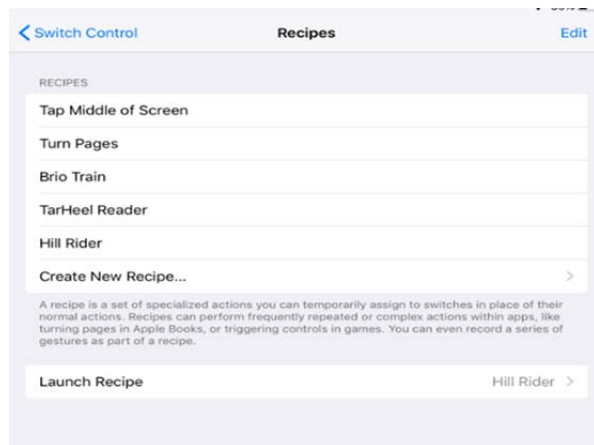
### Tip

- Turn off Switch Access while programming recipes.
- Make sure your screen is not set as a switch

### To Make Recipe

Settings > General > Accessibility > Switch Control > Recipes > Create a New Recipe

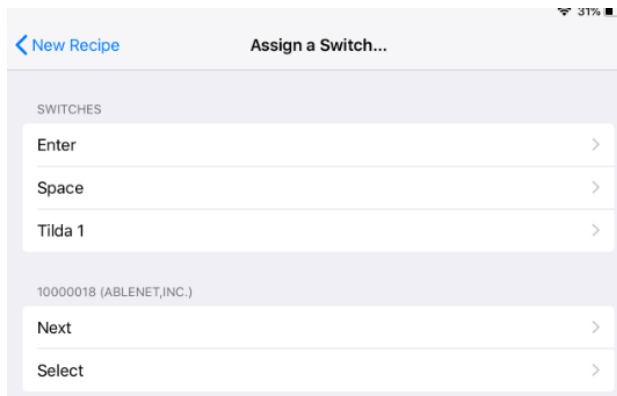
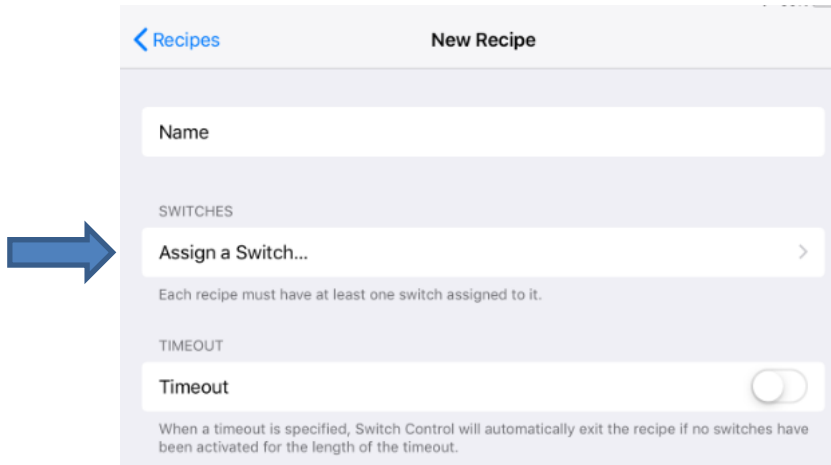
Name it –select a name that goes with your app



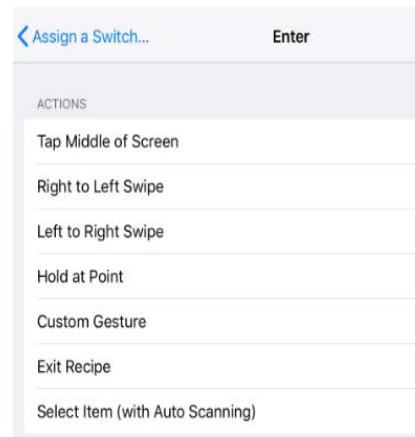
## Switch Assignments for the Recipe

For the Recipe you will be giving different commands than what you previously assigned to the switches. These will only be used when the Recipe is ENABLED.

Set up new commands for each switch.

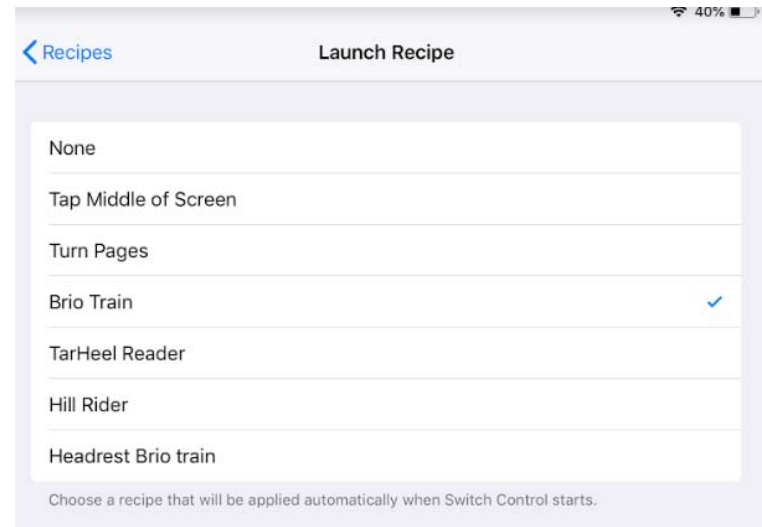
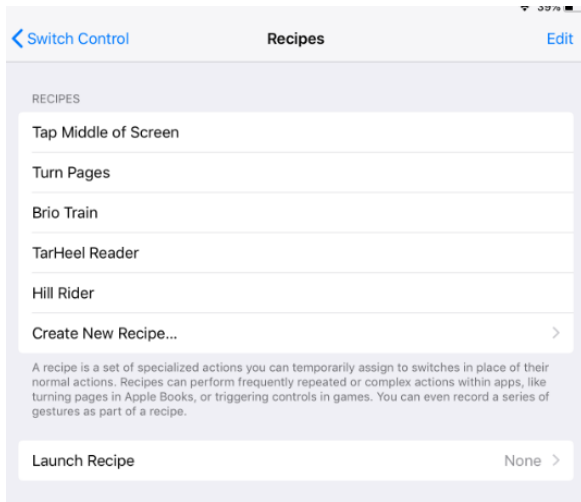


Select the switch desired.



Assign it a new action or custom gesture.

## Launch the Recipe



Select the desired recipe.

Turn on switch control, open app – the chosen recipe will now be in effect.

Test it out to make sure you gestures work as desired.
