 Provides word prediction and spelling error support, reads text aloud, email or copy text

Notes:
 Hear word before you select it, now has voice recognition

Device:

Dragon Dictation

Description:
 Easy to use, accurate voice recognition, dictate then copy/paste or email text

Notes:
 Requires Internet access

 iPad, iPhone, iPod (gen 3 & up with mic)

Description:
 Decent voice recorder with good volume controls, allows pause and resume during recording, does not transcribe to text

Notes:
 Free version includes ads, recordings are saved and emailed

 - Not much recognition difference noted with either

Stylus

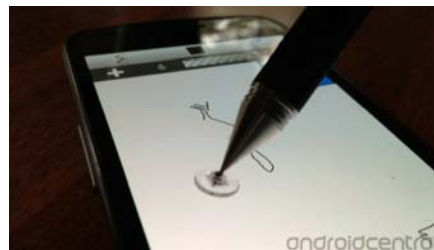
- Stylus
 - Personal preference
 - \$\$ and easy to lose
 - Some with tail that fits into the ear bud slot (left pic)
 - Adonit makes one with nice control
 - Disc tip instead of a nib (right pic & next slide)

 - Lists apps according to Essential, Notable, Decent
- Print n Share Pro
 - Works without a computer
 - Open documents in Print n Share
 - Just like you would any other app
 - Within apps look for PnS in your 'Open In' options
 - Print directly to an ePrint capable printer

Description:
Transcribes handwritten text on the iPad into printed text format



Notes:
Share via Google Docs, email, printer, PDF; translate what you write (?)

Description:
Word prediction lets you hear word before selecting; highlights as it reads text aloud



Notes:
Does not require WiFi, OCR for new iPad only, email, copy, upload to Google, Dropbox, no spell check

Simple clean word processing, some nice additions to keyboard

Description:

Full featured note taking, link audio lecture with typed or stylus notes

Allows user to rest hand on screen while using stylus, email, send to Google docs, Dropbox, open in app, print

Description:

Write notes with stylus, annotate PDFs, linked audio recording, make detailed drawings

Notes:

Share via email, can insert photo, drawing

PaperHelper

\$1.99

Description:

Splits iPad screen half for note taking the other half for researching on Internet

Notes:

Rated +17 because of Internet access only

Device:

iPad only



Side by Side

Free

Description:

Divide the iPad in multiple ways to make areas for reading, web search and notetaking

Notes:

View variety of files, share via email, save to Dropbox, Internet access gives it +17 rating

Magical Pad

\$0.99

Description:

Organize your ideas using outlines or mind maps, very complete, may be too complex for some users

Notes:

Share to Email, Google docs, Dropbox, Evernote; PDF, RTF +others

Device:

Toontastic

Free

Description:

Make animated cartoons using provided art or your own, record motion and your voice

Notes:

Extra package of characters and scenes to buy, share on iPad or Toontastic site

Device:

iPad



Puppet Pals

Free

Description:

Create show with characters and art provided

Notes:

Saves to Photos on iPad can export from there; loses some quality; extras to buy separately (\$2.99)

Device:

iPad, iPhone (separate versions)



StoryKit

Free

Description:

Write text, draw or use photo, record voice or sound

Notes:

Upload stories to private StoryKit link, no account needed

Device:

iPad, iPhone, iTouch
